



## **A New IDC MarketScape Assesses Eight Commercial Content Delivery Network Providers**

August 29, 2019** – International Data Corporation ([IDC](#)) today published a new [MarketScape](#) vendor assessment profiling eight commercial content delivery network (CDN) providers. The companies featured in the report are Akamai, Amazon, CenturyLink, Cloudflare, Fastly, Limelight, Tata Communications, and Verizon.

The commercial CDN market carries a substantial portion of the world's Internet traffic. CDNs facilitate the secure and timely delivery of content to end users, including static and dynamic Web sites, time-sensitive streaming video, large files such as Over the Air (OTA) updates, medical imaging, and more. CDNs may also replicate or store multiple copies of internet content, including Web objects, downloadable objects, applications, live streaming media, on-demand streaming media, and social networks. CDNs typically deploy a set of services to ensure the delivery of content on multiple display formats within well-established performance and quality of service metrics, such as latency, jitter, and throughput.

While CDN traffic is expected to continue growing at a robust pace, revenue growth is being challenged by price erosion, efforts by major content providers to build private CDNs, and the emergence of new competitors leveraging emerging technologies and simplified pricing models. To create differentiation and drive new revenue, CDN providers are offering additional services, such as security services, improving performance parameters, and innovating at the edge.

"Enterprises' expectations of CDN providers are evolving as they undergo the journey to digital transformation. Traditional metrics in terms of performance and availability, while still important, are not enough for the choice of a CDN provider," said [Ghassan Abdo](#), research vice president, [Worldwide Telecommunications](#). "On the technology front, enterprises are expecting an innovation agenda that incorporates virtualization, DevOps, open APIs and programmability at the edge. On the commercial side, enterprises are demanding a commercial framework that is transparent, easy to understand, and embodies co-innovation to enable a richer customer experience. CDN providers that align their technological and commercial roadmaps with the digital transformation journey of the enterprise can become the future leaders."

The report, [IDC MarketScape: Worldwide Commercial CDN 2019 Vendor Assessment](#) (IDC #US44842119), presents an assessment of eight CDN vendors that provide commercial CDN services on a global basis. The assessment is based on their current capabilities and future
